Gifted Students and Alternative Assessment

Tests & Assessments. Tests are common assessment tools for identification, but should not serve as the sole source of identification. Tests often exclude underserved gifted students who are English Language Learners (ELLs), disabled, or from minority or low-income backgrounds.

These assessments are given to a very small number of students with significant cognitive disabilities. Alternate assessments are typically administered individually by a special education teacher.
