All registrars must follow the Uniform Domain-Name Dispute-Resolution Policy (often referred to as the "UDRP"). Under the policy, most types of trademark-based domain-name disputes must be resolved by agreement, court action, or arbitration before a registrar will cancel, suspend, or transfer a domain name.

The cost of a typical domain name arbitration, using a single arbitrator, ranges from \$1200 - \$1500, depending on the arbitration service. Using a panel of 3 arbitrators is more expensive. The other option available to victims of domain name infringement is a lawsuit asserting claims under the Lanham Act and/or the Anti-cybersquatting Consumer Protection Act (ACPA).
