First, we need to translate the word problem into equation(s) with variables. Then, we need to solve the equation(s) to find the solution(s) to the word problems.

Solving word problems relies on using short-term memory to read the problem, decide what is being asked, select numbers, and set up an equation. The steps above are key to lessening the burden on short-term memory. In other words, these rules are most important for students with weaker executive functions or who are anxious about math.

Explain the purpose of word problems. Without proper context, some students may view word problems as unnecessarily complicated. However, they're actually intended to help students use math to solve real world problems, such as building a fence, buying enough food for a party, or adjusting a recipe.

Translating Words to Equations (solutions, examples, videos)
