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The only other thing I want to caution is to beware of doing cataract surgery in diabetics with mild cataracts. Some patients have very mild cataracts and significant diabetic disease. And if we don't make their macular edema worse, we might improve their vision by only 5% or 10%.

Brown-McLean Syndrome (BMS) describes a condition in which the peripheral (2-3mm) inferior cornea become edematous and progresses circumferentially, sparing the central cornea in most cases.[1][2] First described in 1969[1] as "peripheral corneal edema after cataract extraction," it was later renamed to Brown-McLean syndrome.[3]

"If they've had prior vitreomacular surgery or known DR or DME, there are numerous studies that show using nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) for a week before and two to three months after surgery lowers the risk of diabetic-related complications even in uncomplicated cataract surgery," said Steven M.
