Download the Carb Tuning Guide Watch the Super E & G Carb Basic Setup video. Verify carburetor is set to stock settings: Idle mixture screw, 11/4 turns from lightly seated. Idle speed screw, ½ turn clockwise from engagement point. Accelerator adjustment screw, two turns counter-clockwise from seated. Start bike, bring to operating temperature.

The idle jet system (comprised of pilot air jet, pilot fuel jet and pilot fuel screw) controls from 0% to about 25% of the throttle opening. The throttle valve controls 0% to 35% of the throttle opening. The needle jet and jet needle control from 15% to 80% of the throttle opening and the main jet controls 60% to 100%.

Mikuni Motorcycle Carburetor Theory 101. Motorcycle carburetors look very complex, but with a little theory, you can tune your bike for maximum performance. All carburetors work under the basic principle of atmospheric pressure. Atmospheric pressure is a powerful force which exerts pressure on everything.

Important notes about CV carb tuning!. To properly tune, you MUST: 1. Have selected the BEST main jet for full throttle power (not just a "good" main jet - we mean "the BEST main jet" for power at high rpm). That eliminates the common severe tweaking of the midrange and lower tuning ranges to compensate for a "wrong" main jet.

How to Synchronize Motorcycle Carburettors: 10 Steps

Keihin carburetors are only legal in California for racing vehicles, which may never be driven on public highways or waterways. Keihin carburetors are designed to be used with normal pump gasoline. Fuels that contain over 10% alcohol content may damage parts in the carburetors. This may prevent the carburetor from functioning properly.
